

Jiří Pačinek is one of the most significant contemporary Czech and international glass artists. His extensive experience and collaborations with renowned figures—such as the artist and glassmaker

René Roubíček and the architect and designer Bořek Šípek—led him to establish his own brand, Pačinek Glass.

Founded in 2007 in Lindava, the brand has since become a symbol of precise craftsmanship, creative courage and deep respect for Czech glassmaking.

In 2015, Jiří Pačinek opened his own glassworks in Kunratice near Cvikov, a place that continues to attract glass enthusiasts from around the world. Five years later, he unveiled the Crystal Cathedral project, located in the Church of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross in Kunratice. This remarkable space brings together artistic glass and sacred architecture, offering a unique spiritual and aesthetic experience.

The Crystal Garden exhibition at the Prague Botanical Garden is another of his extraordinary projects, continuing his life's work and philosophy of light, form, and harmony.
